When Saied came to the Netherlands to seek Asylum, he was put in a detention centre at Schiphol Airport. He was held there for over a year. During his time there, he sought out ways to oppose the prison regime imposed on him and his fellow Asylum Seekers, and the bullying of the guards. His attempts to make the time in the detention centre more bearable for those who were - and are - held there, did not make him popular with the guards and the direction. This is Saied's story.

B. Carrot (1985, Jerusalem) came to the Netherlands to study in 2016, and ended up living there ever since. After working as an illustrator and writer of stories and comics for some years, she moved to Brussels to do a Master in Graphic Storytelling at the LUCA School of Arts. She graduated in 2019, her thesis became her debut 'Alle dagen Ui', which was published in 2020 at Soul Food Comics. Her work is often socio-politically driven, by subjects such as immigration, feminism, and the Palestinian fight for freedom. She lives and works in Nijmegen.




His cotton shirt was sticking to his back. It was as if every day made sure to be hotter than the one before.













He could hear commotion in the background yet his father's voice was as calm and reassuring as ever.








The luggage hall was a few steps away. He could still see it.
